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Car Park:

If you/grandparents/carers arrive early and there are spaces available in the main car park, I urge you to please use them. Queuing for the playground parking whilst spaces are still available, is causing traffic to back up to the main road from as early as 2:50pm.

Parking on the yellow zigzag lines by the zebra crossing is also not permitted, as it blocks visibility and puts children at risk. These markings are in place to keep everyone safe.

School Dinners:

Please ensure that all outstanding dinner bills are paid in full no later than 23rd January. We urge parents to pay their child's dinners in advance and not retrospectively. This half term's school dinners are £73.95 or £2.55 daily.

After School Collection:

A gentle reminder that it is important that arrangements are made for the children to be collected on time and all children leave the premises promptly. Staff cannot supervise children after this time and often have training / staff meetings to attend to. We also need to know who is in the school for Fire Regulation purposes. We do expect that all Ks1 children are collected by an adult.

September 2026 Admissions:

Do you have a little one ready to start school this September? Now is the time to secure their place at Marown. Early registration allows us to plan effectively and ensure a smooth transition for all our new pupils. If you know families in the local area with children turning school age this year, please encourage them to get in touch with the school office as soon as possible. We are excited to welcome new faces and continue building our wonderful school community.

Swimming / P.E:

Our KS2 swimming sessions begin in February. Miss Halsall has already sent a more detailed letter to all Y3-Y6 parents, but please be aware there is an updated start date. Sessions will begin **Monday 2nd February** and lessons will run for 18 weeks, with the last being Monday 6th July.

Please ensure the children always have their full P.E. kits in school, we do expect these to remain in school for the full half term.
